

Ordinance Approving Contract Between the City of Charleston, Missouri and Union Electric (D/B/A Ameren Missouri) for Lighting of Streets, Avenues, Alleys, and Other Public Places Within the City of Charleston.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Charleston, Missouri as follows:

1. That the proposed contract, in the form hereinafter set out, by and between the City of Charleston, Missouri, herein referred to as "City" and Union Electric Company (D/B/A Ameren Missouri), its successors and assigns, herein referred to as "Company", providing for the lighting of streets, avenues, alleys, and other public places within the City by electricity, and providing for other electric service required by the City for its City Hall and other premises, according to the terms, provisions, stipulations, and agreements therein specified, is hereby approved and confirmed.
2. That City Manager and City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute said contract on behalf of the City in the form set out as Exhibit A attached hereto and made a part hereof.
3. City hereby grants to Company, its successors and assigns, while engaged in the performance of said contract, the right and privilege to erect, maintain, and operate lighting and other electrical fixtures, poles, lines, wires, cables, transformers, and related apparatus and appliances necessary for the performance of said duties, upon, under, over, and across streets, avenues, alleys, and other public places in City.
4. If any provision of the ordinance shall be held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected thereby.
5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance or any of its provisions are, to the extent of such conflict, repealed.
6. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
